Below the Polish version, please include the English version of the title, abstract and keywords, prepared in accordance with the above guidelines.

#### Information on the circumstances in which the text was written.

In the case of publications created within the framework of a research project or grant, it is necessary to provide the formula below in the first footnote:

"The article was created/research was carried out within the framework of a project (title and number of the project in parentheses), carried out at (name of the institution), financed by (name of the funder)."

If the publication is based on a master's thesis or doctoral dissertation, the first footnote should include the following formula:

"The article is based on research conducted as part of a doctoral thesis/master's thesis (title), prepared under scientific supervision (academic degree, name and surname of the supervisor), at [name of university/ faculty/ institute]."
